

# Itaipu Technological Park:

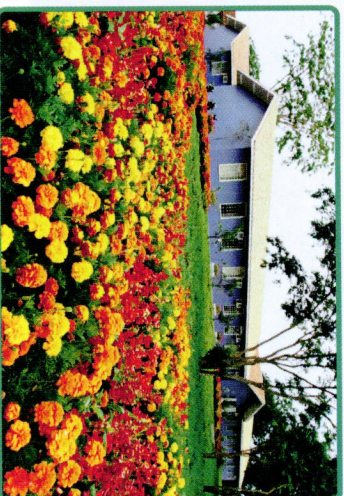
In 2003, Itaipu created the Itaipu Technological Park (PTI).

At present, the site that housed thousands of workers who helped build the Power Plant, has gathered together, in a shared environment and in an area of 50 thousand square metres, close to two thousand people, between staff, trainees, associates, businessmen, researchers, professors and academics.

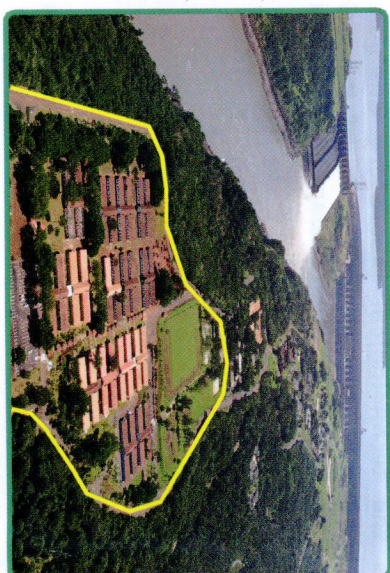
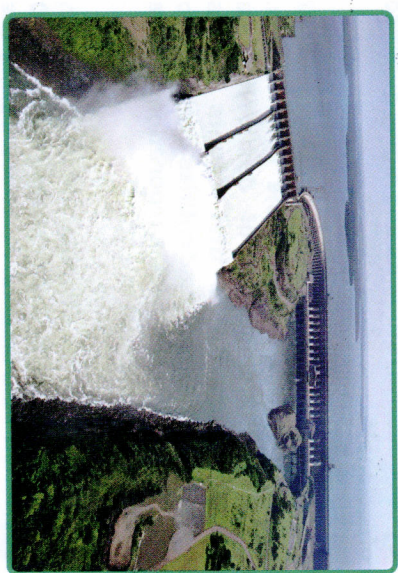
## Technology and Development:
